- **Warren Lake**

- **States Long Weekend**
 - State nominations open 18/11 and registrations open 02/12
 - Further to the above space at Yonkine Regional Space - the state long weekend will look different due to reduced ground space. TBAWA will look further into this.
 - When state players are being registered, all information is required up front such as birth certificates etc
 - There needs to be a Level 2 umpire per every 3 teams for the long weekend.
 - Coaches & assistant coaches must be registered by game day.

- **Coaching Clinics**

Registrations

- U11s and U13s will likely need players throughout the season
- U9s to play up -
 - must have played tee-ball before
 - only eligible to fill in 3 times as per the by-laws
 - to be able to have a fill in the team must have less than 9 players
 - always a few players on standby each week
- Last year an email went to all families if their child was eligible. Issues found - sometimes emails going to junk folder and families advising they didn't know about it.
 - If the list isn't large enough maybe look at having 3 games count to game count and then afterwards any games played to fill in doesn't count

 - It may be easier getting businesses to commit this way and also easier for shirt sizing etc
- **Baseball Coaches Shirts**
 - No baseball shirts for TMs and Coaches
 - Coaches and TMs to be issued supported polo - this is something they can keep and where season after season
 - ** Henry was going to look into a sponsorship to pay for coaches shirts for baseball, however it was discussed in the committee group after the meeting that coaches and TMs would be issued a supporters polo.
